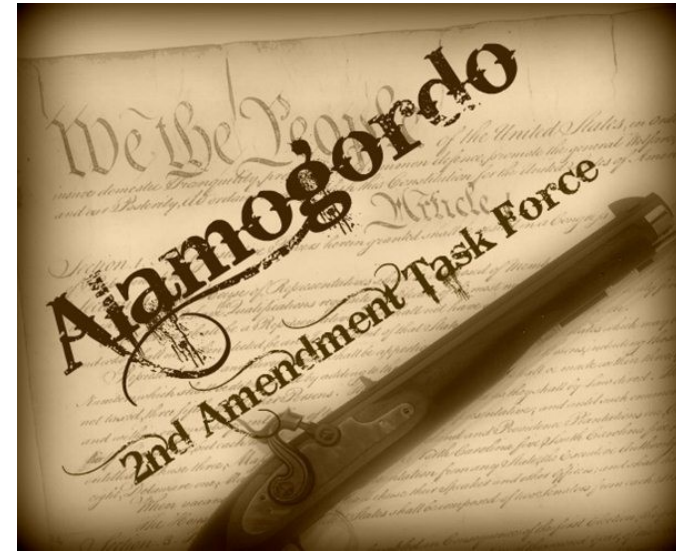

What is a concealed handgun?

NM law defines a "concealed handgun" as "a loaded handgun that is not visible to the ordinary observations of a reasonable person." *Section 29-19-2(D)*.

New Mexico State Constitution:

No law shall abridge the right of the citizen to keep and bear arms for security and defense, for lawful hunting and recreational use and for other lawful purposes, but nothing herein shall be held to permit the carrying of concealed weapons. No municipality or county shall regulate, in any way, an incident of the right to keep and bear arms. *Article II, section 6*

Federal Constitution:

A well regulated militia being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the People to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed. *2nd Amendment*.

States that honor New Mexico concealed weapons permit:

MT, ID, WY, SD, MN, NE, UT, CO, KS, MO, OK, TX, AZ, NM, MI, IN, KY, TN, FL, VA, VT, AK.

New Mexico honors these states concealed weapons permits:

AK, AZ, CO, DE, KY, MI, MN, NC, ND, OH, OK, MO, TN, TX, UT, VA.

From the New Mexico Department of Public Safety :

Question: If I have my gun holstered in "plain view" on my belt will I be breaking the law?

Answer: No, New Mexico is an Open Carry State, meaning it is legal to carry a loaded weapon as long as it is not concealed. However, it is not legal to carry any firearm in any federal building, school, state building, or licensed liquor establishment. It is the responsibility of the person carrying the firearm to be informed as to when/where carrying is prohibited.

Question: Do I have to be licensed to have a concealed loaded handgun inside my vehicle?

Answer: No. New Mexico law allows a person who is not otherwise prohibited to have a concealed loaded firearm in his/her vehicle (including motorcycles and bicycles). See 30-7-2 NMSA 1978. If you are not licensed to carry concealed in this State or in a state that NM recognizes, you may not have the weapon concealed on your person when you exit your vehicle or motorcycle.

Places off limits while carrying in NM:

1. Schools.
2. Federal Buildings.
3. Licensed Liquor establishments that serve, IE. consumption on premises (bars, clubs and restaurants).
4. Licensed Liquor establishments for consumption off premises (gas stations and liquor stores) (concealed carry is legal).
5. State Parks (In national parks carry is legal).
6. On the premises of any private property that the owner has posted signs forbidding carry or if the owner tells you that you cannot carry on his property.
